## SUBJECT: PROVISION OF CLOSED LOOP HEALTH EDUCATION REFERRALS

**PURPOSE:** To ensure all High Desert Health System (HDHS) health education referrals are communicated effectively, patients' cultural and linguistic needs are met, and there is follow-up to ensure a closed loop referral process.

**POLICY:** Follow-up of all health education referrals will be monitored to establish a closed loop, as mandated by LA Care, thereby ensuring that the patients receive the intended health education.

## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Nursing staff at all HDHS clinic sites will provide health education during patient encounters as ordered by providers and when specific learning needs have been identified by nursing staff.
- 2. Health education is provided to patients by a licensed nurse, a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) or by a Health Education Assistant (HEA) during the process of disposition, or at any time prior to discharge from the clinic.
- 3. When there is a need to provide health education follow-up, or to provide cultural and linguistic services, arrangements will be made by nursing staff at the time the follow-up visit is scheduled.
- 4. All patient education encounters will be documented electronically and / or manually in the progress notes.
  - a. The Health Education Assistant (HEA) will completely document in Affinity under the Health Education section all the necessary information regarding the referral including its outcome.
  - b. Patients who missed the health education appointments will be rescheduled by the Health Education Assistant.
  - c. All information will be documented in the medical record.
