Responsibilities:

Establish guidelines for the Bio-medical shop responsibilities, and to ensure all staff use plans, specifications, instruction manuals, and parts lists furnished by the contractors and/or manufacturers, that are now in the shops and/or in the Facilities Managers office.

The Bio-medical supervisor reports to the Assistant Director of the Facilities Management Department.

The shop is responsible for:

- 1. Proper operation, calibration, testing and maintenance of all Hospital Medical Equipment, except Radiology. Dental (X-Ray and OR Sterilizers which are under vendor contract).
- 2. Performing ground resistance and leakage current testing of equipment, including all incoming electrical equipment that plugs into receptacles.
- 3. Performing electrical checks on equipment that is wired direct, (hard wired) and fused at an electrical sub-panel the sub panel is checked annually by the Electric shop.
- 4. Maintaining a current and accurate inventory of all medical equipment.
