RESPONSIBILITIES

The Planning Division is comprised of:

Departmental Facilities Planner II

This section of Facilities Management Department is responsible for:

- Providing Facility Planning Services for the Hospital's Building Alterations and Refurbishment projects which includes Space Planning & Programming, Interior Design, preparation of Construction drawings to be performed by the County Construction personnel, preparation and submission of Materials and Furnishing specifications for purchasing, coordinates the preparation of documents on projects which requires Building Permits/approvals from State, local agencies and Downey Fire Department.
- Providing Scope of Work and Preliminary Cost Estimate for Building Alterations, Refurbishment and Capital Project requests.
- Approving the Plans & Specifications prepared by Contract personnel.
- Project Monitoring during Construction phase to ascertain Compliance with the approved drawings.
- Coordinating the Installation of Equipment, Furniture and Furnishing per approved construction plans.
- Coordinating the Equipment installation to assure all deficiencies are corrected during warranty period.
- Maintaining and updating all Building plans, As-Built drawings, maps, underground utility prints and records of streets, parking lots and sidewalks.
- Participating in various planning and construction meetings in connection with the Hospital Master plan.
