SUBJECT: RECALL OF POTENTIALLY CONTAMINATED ITEMS FLASH STERILIZER FAILURE

Policy No.: OR72 Supersedes: ALL Reviewed Date: 01/2012

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**Policy Statement:** Biological indicators are run daily in the flash sterilizers in the Operating Room to determine the effectiveness of the sterilization process. A method to notify all necessary personnel of a potential sterilizer failure must be available. All necessary personnel will be notified of sterilizer failure.

## **Procedural Steps:**

A positive Attest indicator indicates a potential sterilizer failure.
 KEY POINT: A yellow color in a processed Attest indicator is a positive result.

 The nursing staff member finding a positive Attest indicator will notify the Nurse Manager/Charge Nurse.

KEY POINT: Attest indicator is read in 24 hours.

- 3. The affected sterilizer will not be used until the unit is checked by Building Crafts. A Rapid Readout Attest, which is read in 1 hour, is run. If this Attest is still positive Building Crafts must be notified and sterilizer will not be used.
- 4. If no problems are identified after the Rapid Readout results are negative, another Attest indicator will be run and read in the following 24 hours..
- 5. A positive test on the following day will be reported to Building Crafts immediately. The sterilizer will not be used until all parameters for sterilization are met and a negative Attest result is obtained.
- 6. The surgical schedule for the affected dates will be reviewed. The surgeons performing procedures on the questionable dates will be notified immediately.
- 7. The Nurse Epidemiologist will be notified by the Nurse Manager/Charge Nurse. **KEY POINT:** Affected patient may require follow-up.
