SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION OF STERILE SUPPLIES

Policy No.: OR105 Supersedes: ALL Reviewed Date: 01/16

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Policy Statement: All sterile supplies integrity will be maintained during transportation to the Operating Room.

Performed by: Central Supply Personnel, Operating Room Staff

Policy Guidelines:

 A covered sterile supplies cart is utilized to deliver clean and sterile supplies to the Operating Room

Key Point: Cart must be covered at all times while moving through hallways. The cover must be removed and discarded, prior to entering the surgical suite.

- 2. The employee assigned to the sterile room will check each package to determine that the package has been subjected to the requirements for sterilization as shown by the indicator tape.
- Each package is examined for package integrity and moisture.
 Key Point: Any torn or moist/wet packages must be reprocessed. They are not sterile.
- 4. Rotate all sterile supplies by:
 - a. Replacing new supplies to the rear of the shelf and moving previous supplies to the front for use first.
 - b. Replacing new supplies to the left and moving previous supplies to the right for use first.
- c. Replacing new supplies on the bottom and moving previous supplies to the top for use first. **Key Point:** All outdated items are to be discarded as the new supplies are placed on the shelf.
- 5. If sterile supplies are in a container, place the newest container under the oldest items.
