SUBJECT: PROTOCOL FOR EMERGENCY GI PROCEDURE

Policy No.: SPL12 Supersedes: ALL Reviewed Date: 04/2018

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Purpose of Procedure: To define nursing responsibilities for assisting with an emergency endoscopy when the Special Procedures Laboratory is closed.

Policy Statement: Patients may require emergency endoscopy procedures when the Special Procedures Laboratory is closed. An appropriately stocked endoscopy cart is available in the Special Procedures Laboratory for this purpose.

Performed By: RN

Procedural Steps:

- 1. The physician determines that an emergency situation requires an endoscopy.
- 2. The patient will be prepared for the procedure by the nursing personnel assigned to provide care to the patient, using the written physician orders and the hospital Diagnostic Manual.
- 3. The MD/ICU nurse gathers the necessary equipment/supplies and stocked emergency endoscopy cart from the Special Procedure Lab and brings them to the ICU, where the procedure will be performed.
- 4. After the procedure is completed the MD/ICU Nurse will return the cart, equipment, and supplies to the Special Procedure Lab.
