SUBJECT: HEMORRHOID INJECTIONS

Purpose of Procedure: To provide appropriate care for patients having hemorrhoid injections.

Physician's Order Required: Yes

Performed By: RN

Equipment: - Anal scope

- Gloves
- Lubricant
- Light source
- 4 x 4's
- 10cc syringe
- 5% Ethamolin or medication of MD=s choice for hemorrhoid injection

Procedural Steps:

- 1. Follow patient care standards for care of patient before, during, and after procedure.
- 2. See SGNA manual for Protosigmoid rigid.
- Position patient on gurney on the left side with knees flexed.
 KEY POINT: Positioning on left side facilitates visualization. If the patient is uncooperative or has severe cardiac arrhythmias this procedure is contradicted.
- 4. Explain to the patient the purpose of the test positioning and relaxation methods, approximate length of the procedure, and sensation the patient is likely to experience.
- 5. Observe for potential complications such as- perforation, bleeding, cardiac arrhythmias, and infection. **KEY POINT:** Notify MD if any of these potential complications occur.
