PURPOSE:

To ensure that patient/family education is an integral part of all occupational therapy and recreation therapy programs.

POLICY:

Occupational Therapy and Recreation Therapy staff follow the Administrative Policy and Procedure No. 8832 on Patient, Family and/or Significant Other Education.

Patient/family education shall be a vital part of any occupational therapy and recreation therapy intervention, and is to be individualized, age-specific, and documented in patients' health medical records routinely.

PROCEDURE:

- All incoming staff will be oriented to their responsibilities regarding patient/family 1. and significant other education.
- 2. Patient/family education will be central to the occupational therapy treatment plans with teaching occurring throughout the rehabilitation process.
- 3. Patient/family education will be individualized based on assessed learning needs, learning readiness, abilities and preferences. The learner's cultural and religious practices, emotional barriers, motivation to learn, physical and/or limitations, language differences, financial implications of health care choices, and length of stay are also considered.
- 4. Occupational therapy and recreation therapy documentation will reflect the status of the education of individual patient/family.
