POLICY: DNR ORDERS IN THE OPERATING ROOM/DURING PROCEDURES

PURPOSE: To Provide References (see box below) for patients who have DNR orders.

DEPARTMENTS: ANESTHESIOLOGY

DEFINITIONS: Guidelines apply to competent patients and also to incompetent patients who have previously expressed their preferences.

PROCEDURE: DNR Orders in the operating room/during procedures: The Department of Anesthesiology will be in compliance with Policies on DNR Orders, including:

- b) California Consent Manual
- c) Guidelines approved by the American Society of Anesthesiologists¹
- d) Guidelines from the American Medical Association
