SUBJECT/TITLE: STERILE SCRUB DISTRIBUTION AND EXCHANGE

MD ORDER: Yes () No (X)

POLICY: Scrubs are issued via a scrub exchange system by Linen Distribution personnel authorized Olive View Medical Center employees/visitors. Dirty scrubs are exchanged for clean ones on a one-to-one basis.

PURPOSE: To ensure that an adequate supply of scrub suits are available to staff working in sterile areas as required by Title 22.

DEPARTMENTS: All

PROCEDURE: Maximum of two pair of green (or blue) scrubs are issued to Olive View-UCLA personnel authorized to access the Cardiology Angiography Suite on a regular basis. Permanent staff in these areas are issued two sets of scrubs. Replacement scrubs are \$20 per set. Authorized residents/medical students must do the following to obtain scrubs:

1. A \$20 deposit for one set of scrubs, or a \$40 deposit for two sets of scrubs (maximum is two sets) is made with the OVMC-UCLA cashier on the 2nd floor and receive a cash receipt.
2. Cash receipt will be submitted to the 3B109 Scrub Exchange attendant, and the Olive View-UCLA employee ID badge (or driver's license/other photo ID ONLY IF NOT Olive View-UCLA Medical Center employee) will be shown and recorded.
3. If staff member works in the aforementioned areas requiring scrubs, he/she may fill out a card identifying sterile area where he works, job title, date leaving Olive View-UCLA Medical Center and photo ID#.
4. To retrieve cash receipt, all scrub suits issued must be turned back in to 3B109.
5. Cash receipt must be presented to cashier for original deposit amount.

LIMITED ALTERNATIVE: Paper scrubs are available for visiting staff.

No scrubs other than Olive View-UCLA greens or blues may be worn in the Angiography Suites during a pacemaker/AICD implantation, in order to adhere to infection control regulations.

Scrubs are not to be worn or taken outside of the hospital with the exception of the cafeteria patio and employee break area. Anyone found in violation of scrub guidelines will be instructed to change, and will be issued a written warning. A second violation will result in termination of reusable scrub privileges, with substitutions or disposable scrubs instead.
