SUBJECT/TITLE: NEGATIVE PRESSURE ISOLATION ROOMS

POLICY: Negative Pressure Isolation Rooms are tested monthly by the A/C Shop. If a

Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. (MDR TB) Patient has been or is to be admitted to

the hospital, the isolation room will be checked for negative pressure.

PURPOSE: To establish a procedure and time frame for testing negative pressure isolation

rooms and to establish a procedure to increase the frequency of the testing when Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. (MDR TB) patients have been admitted to the

hospital.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The A/C Shop will take readings on negative pressure isolation rooms monthly.
- 2. The readings are to be documented.
- 3. Reading less than 10 FPM, neutral, or positive are to be reported to the A/C Shop Supervisor immediately.
- 4. Infection Control will notify the Facilities A/C Supervisor if a Multiple Drug Resistant Patient has been admitted to the hospital.
- 5. If a Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. patient has been admitted, the A/C Supervisor shall schedule testing of the isolation room, for negative pressure, immediately.
- 6. It is Infection Control's responsibility to alert the A/C Supervisor, the Director, or the Associate Director of Facilities Division if the Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. patient is admitted.
- 7. If the Director or Associate Director of Facilities is notified that a Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. patient has been admitted to the hospital, he/she shall notify the A/C Supervisor.
- 8. The Infection Control Department will notify Facilities when a Multiple Drug Resistant T.B. patient has been transferred to another isolation room or discharged from the hospital.
