## SUBJECT/TITLE: FIRE SPRINKLER/DETECTION SYSTEM FAILURE

## **PURPOSE:**

**POLICY:** In the event of a loss of any component of the fire sprinkler/detection system in the hospital, the BEAS Room Operator shall take immediate action to set up a fire watch and restore the system.

## **PROCEDURE:** 1. Make an entry into the BEAS Room "Fire Log" Book as to the time and extent of the failure.

- 2. Call the Facilities M.O.D. and request that a fire watch be set for areas of the hospital where the fire system is not working.
- 3. Log the time at which the fire watch was started.
- 4. During normal working hours:
  - a. Call the Facilities Office (ext. 3325)
  - b. Call Hospital Administration (ext. 3001) and report that the fire system is not working and that a fire watch is being performed in the compromised areas.
  - c. Log the time and name of the Hospital Administrator.
  - d. Call the L.A.F.D. (818) 756-8691, and inform the fire captain that the hospital has a compromised fire system and that we are on "Fire Watch".
- 5. During off hours:
  - a. Call the Facilities MOD to set a fire watch and to get permission to callback an electrician/plumber to repair the problem.
  - b. Call the Nurse Administrator to report that the fire system is not working and that a fire watch has been set in the compromised areas.
  - c. Call County Sheriff to report that the hospital is on fire watch.
  - d. Log the time of arrival and name of the electrician/plumber.
  - e. Call the Facilities MOD to report, either that the repairs have been made or that repairs were not completed, prior to the electrician/plumber leaving the hospital.
  - f. Call the Sheriff and report that the fire system has either been repaired or that the system has not been repaired and that the fire watch control must continue.
  - g. Call the Nurse Administrator to report the status of the fire system.

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	h.	Call the L.A.F.D. (818) 756-8691, and inform the fire captain that the hospital has a compromised fire system and that we are on "Fire Watch".
	i.	Log the time of all of the above calls and the name of the person you talked to.
