PROCEDURE:

1. There will be a recorded message telling you that this is an elevator emergency and where the emergency is. DO NOT HANG-UP. Wait until the recorded message is stopped, then speak to the other party. You will initiate the conversation by telling them who you are, and asking them if they are trapped in the elevator. If you do not get a response it does not mean that this is a false alarm. The person trapped may be MUTE, or they may be phobic (frightened), or they may not understand English. Should you speak with someone that is trapped in the elevator assure them that help is on the way. Ask if anyone will need medical help. Do not incite them, assure them that it will just a little while.

Notify Facilities elevator mechanic.

The beeper I the best way to contact him, as he may not be on the grounds. Beep the number tree times at two minute intervals. 529-0210 is the beeper number

<u>DO NOT CANCEL</u> the call for the elevator mechanic because you do not get a response from the clinic. Time can be of the essence with sick and crowded people. The elevator mechanic will get in touch with you as soon as he can, either in person or by having someone notify you that he has arrived.

- 2. The following steps should be taken in the event of an elevator entrapment at any ValleyCare facility when the Facilities Elevator Mechanic is not available.
 - Alert ValleyCare Safety Police, ex. 3409, give them the location and elevator number (hospital entrapments only).
 - Instruct General Maintenance Worker on duty to report to elevator (hospital entrapments only). They should remain on site to assist.
