SUBJECT/TITLE: EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR ELEVATOR ENTRAPMENTS

**POLICY:** 

**PURPOSE:** To establish guidelines that should be implemented in the event of elevator

entrapment at any ValleyCare facility when the Facilities' Elevator Mechanic is

not available.

**PROCEDURE:** 

- 1. Alert ValleyCare Safety Police x3409; give them the location and elevator number (hospital and grounds entrapments only).
- 2. Instruct General Maintenance Worker on duty to report to elevator (hospital entrapments only). They should remain on site to assist.
- 3. Contact Electrical Supervisor. Ask him to report to the elevator to assess the situation.
- 4. If unable to contact Electrical Supervisor, contact LAC-USC Medical Center Dispatch: (323) 226-6636.
- 5. If unable to contact Electrical Supervisor or LAC-USC Elevator Mechanic, contact the Los Angeles City Fire Department at (818) 785-2151.
