POLICY: The hospital shall maintain critical and life safety system circuit on an emergency

power source, maintaining and testing them in accordance with JCAHO and

NFPA Standards.

PURPOSE:

PROCEDURE: The following systems are powered by emergency power source:

1. Alarm systems

- 2. Exit route illumination
- 3. Emergency communication systems
- 4. Illumination of exit signs
- 5. Blood, bone, and tissue storage units
- 6. Emergency/urgent care areas
- 7. Elevators (at least one for nonambulatory patients)
- 8. Medical air compressors
- 9. Medical and surgical vacuum systems
- 10. Areas where electrically powered life-support equipment is used
- 11. Operating rooms
- 12. Post-operative recovery rooms
- 13. Obstetrical delivery rooms
- 14. Newborn nurseries

The above systems are inspected and tested regularly for proper operation of equipment.
