SUBJECT/TITLE: RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

POLICY: ValleyCare shall have a Risk Assessment Program which is designed to proactively evaluate the impact of buildings, grounds, equipment, occupants, and internal physical systems on patient and public safety. Inherent in the program is the obligation to take corrective action when a problem is detected and to provide follow-up to corrective actions taken.

PURPOSE: To establish a risk assessment program addressing concerns regarding patients, visitors, personnel, and property.

DEFINITIONS:

PROCEDURE: The Risk Assessment Program is carried out using reports from various divisions such as hazard surveillance reports, Safety Police reports, equipment and utility incident reports. Reports from other agencies such as Fir Department, State or County Department of Health Services, and insurance Companies should be utilized whenever appropriate.

Summary of the safety incidents involving patients, visitors, personnel, and property shall be reported to the Safety Committee.
