PROCEDURE: To Report An Incidental Mercury Spill inside and outside the Hospital

1. Remove everyone from the area.

2. Call ext. 3405 and ask for the Safety Officer, after hours call the hospital operator at ext. 111.

3. Explain that you are calling to report a mercury spill.

4. Give the location and extent of the spill.

5. Notify immediate supervisor.

6. The Safety Officer will direct the clean up of the spill.
