SUBJECT/TITLE: POLICY ON FIRE DETECTION AND RESPONSE-EQUIPMENT INSPECTIONS AND TESTS

- **POLICY:** It is the policy of Facilities to ensure that major life and fire safety equipment is inspected periodically and maintained in accordance with The Joint Commission Environment of Care, Life Safety, and NFPA standards.
- **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this policy is to define inspection and maintenance activity of major life safety equipment according to established schedule.
- **DEPARTMENTS:** FACILITIES
- **DEFINITIONS:**
- **RESPONSIBILITY:** Director of Facilities Plumbing Shop Supervisor Electric Shop Supervisor General Maintenance Shop Supervisor
- **PROCEDURE:** A. The Statement of Conditions that describes the current condition of the buildings' structural features of fire protection is maintained by the Director and is kept tin the Facilities Management office.
 - B. The circuits of fire alarm and fire detection systems are inspected periodically receive preventive maintenance, based on the table below and Records of inspections and maintenance are on file in the office of the Electric Shop Supervisor.
 - C. Fire pumps and sprinklers inspected and tested based on the table below as required by The Joint Commission Life Safety and Environment of care standards. Records of inspections and testing are on file in the office of the Plumbing Shop Supervisor.
 - D. All portable fire extinguishers are inspected monthly and maintained annually. Records of inspection and maintenance on file in the office of the General Maintenance Shop Supervisor.
