STEPS/KEY POINTS

- 1. The nurse in the FAC may transfer a patient to Labor and Delivery when immediate observation of the patient is indicated, as in the case of a prolonged non- responsive fetal heart rate bradycardia.
 - Patient will be taken by wheelchair or FAC chair.
- 2. The FAC nurse will give the accepting nurse in Labor and Delivery report. Whenever possible, the resident accepting the patient will also be given report.
- 3. The fetal monitoring strip will be available for review either on the archiving system or via hard copy.
 - The physician in FAC requesting the transfer/admission is responsible for notifying the Senior Resident of the impending admission.
- 4. L&D staff will register and admit the patient to Labor and Delivery.

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• A patient transferred from an outpatient setting to an inpatient ward will need to be admitted.
