PURPOSE: To define the educational requirements of nursing staff in the Fetal Assessment

Center

DEPARTMENTS: Medicine, Nursing 3D- Fetal Assessment

DEFINITIONS:

PROCEDURE: A. Basic

- 1. All Registered Nurses must successfully complete their Orientation Program in Fetal Assessment; including fetal monitoring and Limited Ultrasonography. They must demonstrate competence in skills as defined in the orientation plan under the supervision of an RN preceptor and the Nurse Manager.
- 2. Other categories of staff must complete defined Orientation Programs to the service and must demonstrate competence in needed skills.
- B. Continuing Education
 - 1. All categories of staff must have continuing education classes.
 - 2. Continuing education will be provided on an ongoing basis within the service as related to Obstetrics and Newborn care.
 - a. All employees will have annual or bi-annual conferences on:
 - i. Advanced Fetal Monitoring
 - b. Nursing Staff are encouraged and expected to participate in ongoing medical or nursing OB conferences.
- C. DHS Annual competencies

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- 1. All nursing staff will complete annual competencies set forth by DHS. This includes:
 - a. Skills lab
 - b. Unit specific competencies

DOCUMENTATION: Proof of completion will be kept in the employees' file.
