SUBJECT/TITLE: USE OF BAIR HUGGER

**POLICY:** The Bair Hugger may be applied to the patient to increase an undesirably low body

temperature. Bair Hugger unit must be cleaned after each patient use.

**PURPOSE:** To provide guidelines in the use of Bair Hugger machine.

**DEPARTMENTS:** Medicine, Nursing 5B - Intensive Care Unit

**DEFINITIONS:** The Bair Hugger is an external warming device applied to the patient to increase an

undesirably low body temperature. Bair Huggers use forced-air-warming system,

which is delivered to a special disposable blanket.

**PROCEDURE:** 1. Verifies physician's orders

- 2. Attaches warming blanket to Bair Hugger machine
- 3. Plugs into AC outlet
- 4. Washes hands before and after procedure
- 5. Wait at least two minutes for warming blanket to fill with warm air.
- 6. Applies to part of the body as ordered by the physician
- 7. Does not use on infants or unconscious patients Checks for skin damage due to varying skin sensitivity

## Cleaning the exterior surface

The exterior surface of the Bair Hugger can be cleaned and disinfected using t recommended cleaner or disinfectant. Bair Hugger unit must be cleaned after patient use.

- 1. Clean the surfaces using a soft cloth lightly dampened in a mild soap or detergent cleaning solution.
- 2. Wipe the surfaces with the disinfecting solution. PDI Super Sani Cloth is recommended.
- 3. Air dry or towel dry with a clean cloth.
- 4. Place a clean plastic cover over the Bair Hugger machine to indicate that equipment has been cleaned/disinfected and ready for use.
