SUBJECT/TITLE: PORTABLE EMG RECORDING - PROCEDURAL PROTOCOL

POLICY:

All of the EMG settings, history taking, time limits, and infection control guidelines are the same as in the routine EMG protocol (see previous section), with a few differences which are described below.

- 1. The procedure is done portably, at a regular bedside or in an intensive care unit.
- 2. If at a regular bedside, the routine EMG protocol is used.
- 3. If the portable recording is in the intensive care unit, the routine EMG protocol is followed.
- 4. All applicable isolation procedures are followed (see infection control protocol). If the patient is in isolation, after the recording the machine is disinfected using a combination of Citrace spray and Bactoshield CHG 2% (or disinfection per updated infection control procedures) prior to returning to the EMG lab.
- 5. All procedures shall be reviewed and signed by the Attending Physician supervising the EMG/NCV procedure.
