PURPOSE:	To outline and define the expected standards of care for the Maternal Child/Perinatal Nursing service

PROCEDURE:	<ul> <li>A. Every patient admitted to the Maternal Child Nursing Service may expect to receive the following:</li> <li>Provisions for a safe environment for patients, employees, and visitors.</li> <li>A plan of care shall be developed for each patient based on a nursing assessment.</li> <li>There will be implementation of a nursing care plan with specific goals and interventions, which take into account the age-specific developmental needs of each patient. The plan of care will be evaluated and revised as necessary.</li> <li>The needs of the family and significant others will be taken into account when the plan of care is developed and implemented.</li> <li>Consistent care will be provided by adherence to the plan of care.</li> <li>Medication will be administered as prescribed in keeping with professional and legal guidelines and hospital policies.</li> <li>The patient, family, and significant others will be informed, taught concerning the individual health care needs during hospitalization and in preparation for discharge from the hospital.</li> <li>The nursing staff will coordinate with other health professionals to achieve continuity of care.</li> <li>Information regarding diagnosis, treatment, or other relevant facts will be treated with confidentiality in accordance with hospital policy.</li> </ul>
