SUBJECT/TITLE: CCT: FACILITY PERSONNEL ROLE DURING CRITICAL CARE TRANSPORT

- **POLICY:** Facility Personnel Role During Critical Care Transport
- **PURPOSE:** The facility personnel may participate in the transport of the critically ill patient if he/she is an employee of the accepting or transferring facility.
- **DEPARTMENTS:** ALL

DEFINITIONS:

PROCEDURE: The CCT RN or therapist will have leadership responsibilities during the transport to ensure the enforcement of transport policies. The facility personnel shall function under the policies and procedures of their employer for their stated role, but within the acceptable policies and procedures set forth by Care Ambulance Services, Inc. These policies and procedures will be reviewed prior to transport.

The safety and optimum care of the patient shall be of the first priority in all circumstances.

Should facility personnel participate in the transport of the patient, the transport nurse or therapist will documents such on the transports record.
