SUBJECT/TITLE: EUCHARISTIC MINISTER VISITATIONS

- **POLICY:** Eucharistic Ministers will be allowed to come to Olive View-UCLA Medical Center inpatient units (4A, 4D, 4BN, 4BS, 5A, 5C and 5D) from St. Didacus Church on Sunday mornings to provide Holy Communion to interested patients.
- **PURPOSE:** In keeping with hospital policies, we are instituting new procedures regarding Eucharistic Minister visitations for Olive View patients.

DEPARTMENTS: PASTORAL SERVICES, PROVISION OF CARE

DEFINITION:

- PROCEDURE
 1. Sundays before 9:00 a.m., Eucharistic Minister checks in at the Administrative Nursing Office (ANO) and picks up temporary badge labeled as Eucharistic Minister Temporary Visitor.
 *A list of St. Didacus Eucharistic Ministers is kept at the ANO.
 - 2. Eucharistic Minister proceeds to assigned unit station and informs unit clerk or charge nurse of presence and intent to administer Holy Communion; unit clerk or charge nurse provide Catholic patient roster to Eucharistic Minister.
 - 3. Eucharistic Minister identifies patients on roster and if patients are interested administers Holy Communion.
 - 4. Eucharistic Minister informs unit clerk or charge nurse when the administration of Holy Communion has ended and returns Catholic patient roster for proper disposal.
 - 5. Eucharistic Minister proceeds to the ANO and returns temporary badge
