POLICY: A washer and dryer are available for patients' laundry needs during hours

established by the unit. Laundry hours will be from 6:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M.

daily.

On admission, patients will be informed of:

1. availability of laundry services

2. laundry hours

3. patient responsibilities, i.e. gathering of their soiled clothing

PURPOSE: The adult mental health unit program utilizes the activities of daily living in a

goal-directed way to foster adequate self-care and physical and mental wellbeing of patients. Washing one's personal clothing to maintain hygiene is one of

the tasks of daily living.

EQUIPMENT LIST: Detergent with bleach alternative; Washer; Dryer

DEPARTMENTS: MENTAL HEALTH NURSING

PROCEDURE: Nursing staff will:

1. determine the appropriateness of clothing/articles that can be placed in the washer/dryer.

- 2. wash and dry each patient load separately to ensure against lost or misplaced articles of clothing
- 3. adhere to Standard/body fluid precautions and don PPE when appropriate
- 4. disinfect washer between each patient load by wiping with sani-cloth germicidal disposable wipes and following manufacture's recommendations for contact time
- 5. update the log each time with staff initials and acknowledge that washer is disinfected between each load.
- 6. acknowledge in the log that dryer vent is being cleaned after each use.
