SUBJECT/TITLE: THERAPEUTIC ARTS AND CRAFTS GROUP PROGRAM IN

PSYCHIATRY

POLICY: Occupational and Recreation Therapy staff provide a therapeutic arts and crafts

group program for the inpatients in psychiatry.

PURPOSE: To assure staff are compliant with all safety guidelines and to make sure

therapeutic arts and crafts activities are conducted in a safe manner for patients.

DEPARTMENTS: REHABILITATION SERVICES

DEFINITIONS: Therapeutic arts and crafts is a form of expressive therapy that uses a creative

process of making art that benefits a person's physical, mental and emotional

well-being.

PROCEDURE: I. Schedule:

- 1. The arts and craft program is scheduled Monday through Friday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. and it is held in Room 6D135.
- 2. An alternate art program is periodically conducted in the Day Room to provide patients the opportunity to participate in team/social projects such as creating holiday banners.

II. Safety Guidelines:

- 1. Patients are continually monitored during the entire arts and craft program with a minimum of two staff members present at all times.
- 2. Only authorized staff may distribute art and craft supplies to patients, which are kept in locked storage cabinets.
- 3. Blunt tip (child sized) scissors may be issued to only one patient at a time. Scissors are collected from the patient immediately after use.
- 4. Under vigilant supervision, a patient may use a craft tool on the work bench. The tool is collected from the patient immediately after use.
- 5. Patients may not remove their art projects or any art materials from the Arts and Crafts Room.
- 6. Patients are ONLY permitted to take the following items back to their room:

- Prison Pen
- Crayola
- Paper
- Word search/puzzle
- Magazines
- Books
- 7. The digital audio machine (radio-CD player) is operated only by authorized staff.
- 8. Patients are required to wear appropriate attire, including protective footwear.

III. Storage Requirements:

- 1. The following craft supplies are kept in a locked storage cabinet:
 - Scissors
 - String
 - Wire
 - Lanyard materials
 - Paint
 - Glitter
 - Art/craft kits
- 2. The following tools are kept in a separate locked cabinet above the workbench:
 - Hammers
 - Pliers
 - Screw drivers
 - Wood burner
 - Nails/screws
- 3. The patient's completed art/craft project(s) are stored in their personal locker until they are discharged from Olive View.

IV. Modalities may include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Painting/drawing
- 2. Beading
- 3. Tile projects
- 4. Wood model projects
- 5. A selection of various craft kits
- 6. Clay sculpting
- 7. Lanyards

V. Other:

- 1. Adaptive devices will be offered to address the special needs of individuals with disabilities.
- 2. In addition to art and craft activities, patients have the option of

reading and playing the guitar.

VI. Goals:

- 1. Assist patient in focusing externally on a purposeful activity rather than on internal stimuli.
- 2. Increase perceptual awareness (spatial relations, form constancy, and figure ground)
- 3. Increase awareness of leisure activities that can carry over after discharge
- 4. Increase attention span with step-by step instructions to complete a multi-step craft project.
- 5. Increase a sense of independence and a feeling of control.
- 6. Increase self-esteem and positive body image.
- 7. Increase problem-solving skills
- 8. Facilitate self-expression
- 9. Alleviate anxiety
