PROCEDURE: 1. GENERAL

- a) To be knowledgeable and current in all clinical aspects of respiratory care, thereby to serve as a resource for staff Respiratory Care Practitioners and hospital physicians using Respiratory Care Services.
- b) To strive to upgrade hospital respiratory care practices by obtaining a broad view of national practices and then attempting to introduce these in a cost-effective fashion.
- c) To work with colleagues at other facilities to improve staffing and practices in Respiratory Care in the County of Los Angeles.

2. SPECIFIC

- a) To meet with the Manager of Respiratory Care Services regularly, to supervise, evaluate him, and provide professional support for his efforts.
- b) To meet with staff RCP's on the Wards to help solve clinical and policy problems
- c) To carry out periodic work rounds and to provide Quality Assurance evaluations.
- d) To work with other Pulmonary Faculty Physicians and Fellows to ensure high quality Respiratory Care throughout the hospital.
- e) To help the Respiratory Care Services department develop budgets,

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training, special resources, research initiatives, bureaucratic responses and administrative plans in all aspects of the Department's work.
