PURPOSE:

To provide academic counseling and remediation for students who failed the Drug Dosage Calculation Competency

POLICY:

Students who failed the Drug Dosage Calculation Competency are counseled.

A Drug Dosage Calculation Competency Remediation Plan (DDCCRP) is developed by the student and faculty to facilitate student success.

Failure of the second Drug Dosage Calculation Competency (DDCC) will result in administrative withdrawal of student from all currently enrolled courses.

PROCEDURE:

The instructor:

- Meets with student regarding remediation plan
- Ensures completion of all sections of DDCCRP form:
- Provides student with a copy of the signed form
- Notifies semester coordinator when placed on remediation plan
- Documents final outcome and notifies semester coordinator
- Attaches finalized DDCCRP form to student's Clinical Performance Evaluation Summary

The student:

- Makes an appointment to meet with Instructor
- Completes the Student's Plan To Achieve Success section on DDCCRP
- Retakes the second DDCC as scheduled.

The semester coordinator/designee:

- Forwards a copy of the completed DDCCRP to the student file
- Completes the Student Status Report.
