PURPOSE:

To provide an opportunity for LVN-RN Option II students to enhance their pharmacology knowledge.

POLICY:

Students enrolled in the LVN-RN Option II program (30 unit option) may enroll in the third semester pharmacology course N231 (one unit). This course is not mandatory for LVN Option II students.

The course may be taken for a grade or credit/no credit.

Tuition will be charged.

Students who enroll in the course are responsible for completing all course requirements.

PROCEDURE:

Dean, Administrative and Student Services will inform all LVN-RN Option II students about the course, available options and requirements.

Students who enroll in the course and the chosen grading option (grade or credit/no credit) will be identified on the class roster given to the Semester 3 Coordinator.
