SUBJECT: PERINATAL MEDICINE SERVICES

POLICY NO. 251

PURPOSE::

To provide those services which promote the birth of a healthy infant to a healthy woman, with the greatest opportunity for optimal emotional, mental, and physical development.

POLICY::

The following elements will be part of the Department's program in providing perinatal medical services to residents of the County:

- 1. Education of the community on the medical, nutritional, and psychosocial needs of the pregnant and potentially pregnant woman.
- 2. Early detection of pregnancy.
- 3. Early and continuous assessment of each pregnancy for high risk conditions, with timely provision of appropriate intervention in the antepartum, intrapartum, and postpartum states.
- 4. Retention of the delivered patient in the health maintenance system.
