SUBJECT: MAXIMAL STERILE BARRIER PRECAUTIONS

PURPOSE::	To establish the practice of maximal sterile barrier precautions as a method of minimizing infection for central line insertion.
SCOPE::	This policy applies to all healthcare workers who perform or assist with central line insertion.
POLICY::	Central line placement using maximal sterile barrier precautions is an evidence-based practice in concert with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines.
	All central lines placed, with the exception of those placed during a code or dire emergency, shall be placed using maximal sterile barrier precautions. Maximal sterile barrier is defined as:
	The use of all of the following equipment:
	Cap Mask Sterile gown Sterile gloves Large sterile drape
