**SUBJECT:** LICENSING AND ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS:

**POLICY NO. 392.1** 

**PURPOSE::** To delineate the Department's policy regarding Licensing and Accreditation

Requirement: "Program Flexibility" and/or "Equivalency."

**DEFINITION:** "Equivalency" means documented evidence that compliance with the intent of

a JCAH standard has been achieved in a manner other than prescribed by the

standard.

"Program Flexibility" means approval by State licensing officials for the use of "alternate concepts, methods, procedure, techniques, equipment, or personnel

qualifications" in lieu of prescribed licensing regulations.

**POLICY::** Program flexibility/equivalency shall be considered only after alternative

solutions have been explored in depth by operational personnel, with the assistance, as needed, of the appropriate central technical office. All requests for program flexibility/equivalency in meeting licensing and accreditation

requirements shall be reviewed and approved by the Director or his designee.

**GUIDE::** Program flexibility/equivalency requests shall be reviewed through the chain of

command and approved by the facility Administrator and appropriate Assistant Director. Consultation should be obtained from the DHS Quality Assurance

Program.

Reasons for each request shall be fully documented at the facility level. Copies of each request, and responses from licensing and JCAH officials, shall be

submitted to the Quality Assurance Program.
