SUBJECT: WATER CONSERVATION

- **PURPOSE:** To reduce water consumption and lower operating costs of the Department.
- **POLICY::** To reduce water consumption to achieve voluntary or mandatory water use restrictions imposed by water or other regulatory agencies. The following water conservation efforts are to be emphasized:
 - Water conservation under the Department's immediate control (e.g., faucets, shower heads, irrigation systems, steam generating boilers, etc.). Each facility is to develop a water conservation plan based upon the facilities' respective water sources and requirements.
 - 2. Water consumption by facility contractors (e.g., landscaping or gardening).
 - 3. Innovative and cost-effective water conservation programs sanctioned by the California Health & Safety Code (e.g., water-flow devices on X-ray processors, or use of recycled water in laundry or lawn irrigation systems.)
- **GUIDE:** Building Crafts Managers are to manage facility water requirements within guidelines established by regulatory water agencies or by the Board of Supevisors.
- AUTHORITY:: California Health & Safety Code California Administrative Code DHS Policy No. 970, effective Novenber 24, 1975.
