ASSESSMENT:

NURSING CLINICAL PROTOCOL

N-ACETYLCYSTEINE INTRAVENOUS FOR ACETAMINOPHEN OVERDOSE – ICU/ED

PURPOSE: To outline the management of patients receiving N-acetylcysteine (NAC) intravenously

for acetaminophen overdose.

Acetaminophen toxicity potentially causes hepatic necrosis which can be fatal. **SUPPORTIVE**

Acetylcysteine Injection (Acetadote ®) is the antidote for acetaminophen overdose and DATA:

is indicated for known or suspected acetaminophen toxicity.

INITIAL ASSESSMENT: 1. Assess the following prior to administration:

• Baseline level of consciousness (LOC)Vital signs (VS)

• IV patency

2. Obtain laboratory tests as ordered (APAP (acetaminophen levels), PT/INR, Liver

function tests).

3. Assess during administration: **ONGOING**

• Signs/symptoms (S/S) of allergic reaction

• LOC minimum of every 2 hours

• VS every 30 minutes x2 after initiation of infusion then per routine

Lab results as drawn

ADMINISTRATION: 4. Ensure that physician is immediately available for the duration of the first dose.

Administer as follows:

• Loading dose of 150 mg/kg (maximum: 15 grams) over 1 hour

• Second dose: 50 mg/kg (maximum: 5 grams) infused over 4 hours

• Third dose: 100 mg/kg (maximum: 10 grams) infused over 16 hours

6. STOP infusion immediately if S/S of an allergic reaction occurs and notify **SAFETY**

physician.

REPORTABLE 7. Report the following to the physician: **CONDITIONS:**

• S/S of allergic/anaphylatic reaction

• Change in LOC • Deterioration in VS

• Deterioration in laboratory values

8. Instruct on the following: PATIENT/FAMILY TEACHING:

• Purpose of the drug

• Side effects

• Need to notify nurse for the following:

Redness/itching/hives

Difficulty breathing

 Grieving PROTOCOLS:

• Intravenous Therapy

Suicidal Patient
