PURPOSE

To provide continuing comprehensive safety education and training for employees of the LAC+USC Medical Center.

POLICY

The LAC+USC Medical Center shall establish an ongoing safety education and training program for all employees in order to maintain and/or improve staff knowledge and skill necessary to perform their duties safely.

<u>PROCEDURE</u>

The training and continuing education program shall cover, but not limited to, the following topics as appropriate:

- Ergonomics
- Fire/Life Safety (a.k.a. Emergency Preparedness Training)
- General Safety and Site Specific Safety
- Hazard Communication Program
- Infection Control, including Bloodborne Pathogens Exposure Control Plan and Aerosol Transmissible Diseases Exposure Control Plan
- Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP)
- New Employee Safety Orientation
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Tram Safety
- Violence in the Workplace
