SUBJECT: DEPARTMENTAL SAFETY PROGRAM Revised: Jan

PURPOSE:

To provide a safe and hazard-free environment for patients, visitors and staff and to encourage staff participation in the safety program of the department and the medical center.

POLICY:

The Occupational Therapy and Recreation Therapy Department will conduct monthly safety/environmental rounds in each of the clinical areas headed by the OT clinical manager or RT supervisor appointed by the Director of Occupational Therapy and Recreation Therapy. The primary purpose of the rounds is to: 1) identifying, to the extent possible, any hazards that may exist in the occupational therapy and recreation therapy clinical areas, 2) encourage staff observance of safety measures of the department and the medical center and 3) identify any environment of care issues that need to be corrected.

PROCEDURE:

- A. The rounds are conducted monthly in the various treatment areas in order to inspect each area thoroughly:
 - 1. Conduct the monthly safety inspection using the Safety/Environment of Care Check-List (Attachment A).
 - a. The original of the Safety Inspection Checklist will be filed in the department's Safety Notebook with copies to the Clinical Manager of the area inspected or R.T. Supervisor, and the department head, and the department director.
 - b. The Clinical Manager or R.T. Supervisor of the area inspected is responsible for assuring that corrective action takes place and for sending the safety inspection sheet with notations of actions taken to the department head or designee within two weeks of the inspection.
 - 2. Receive and act on suggestions and recommendations from staff regarding safety concerns and practices.
